A GO-GETTER WITH ENTREPRENEURIAL aspirations, Edward started dabbling in startups after he graduated from Shanghai Jiao Tong University, with a major in the Internet of Things and Communication. With a keen interest in the sharing economy and technology, his initial startups centred around these ideas. In 2016, the green advocate in him jumped on the opportunity to start a bike-sharing service in Singapore in a bid to reduce traffic congestion and carbon emission.

He co-founded oBike with a few like-minded entrepreneurs, leveraging on technology to provide an alternative short-distance commute option to urbanites, raising US\$45 million within 8

Founder of Eversendai, a company worth over USD 1 billion; one of Asia's most successful businessmen

A. K. NATHAN ELUMALAY, THE FOUNDER of Eversendai, built the company from a modest structural steel erection company in Malaysia to one of world's most sought after integrated steel structural turnkey contractors. From humble beginnings as a printing machine operator, to now spearheading one of the most prominent companies in the world – his sheer determination, keen enthusiasm and acute attention to fine details have served as the driving power behind the development of the Eversendai Group.

Some of the prominent structures built by Eversendai during its 3 decades of operations include the Petronas Twin Towers (Tower 2), Kuala Lumpur International Airport, Burj Al Arab, Burj Khalifa, Doha International Airport and Capital Gate. Today, Eversendai has a workforce of over 15,000 in 9 countries and operates out of 14 offices, producing a combined annual capacity of over 234,000 tonnes.

His charismatic approach to business and the construction industry has earned him many accolades. Some notable ones are the Golden Construction Award 2008 from the Trade Leaders Club in Madrid, Spain, the Malaysian Entrepreneur of the Year 2008 from Ernst & Young, the CEO of the Year Award in 2008 by CIDB and the Lifetime Achievement Award for Leadership in Construction Industry by the World Chinese Economic Forum in 2015.

In December 2017, oBike announced that it will be partnering blockchain platform Tron to officially launch oCoins in the first quarter of 2018. oBike users will be able to pay for their rides and top up their oBike wallets using oCoins, it can also be used to buy online content or be used on any application that is on Tron's platform.

Fortune magazine's annual list of The World's 50 Greatest Leaders who are stepping up to meet today's challenges includes **Mick Cornett**, former mayor of Oklahoma City. If you're a fiscally conservative mayor in a fiscally conservative city, how do you persuade

voters to pay more for public works? Cornett proposed tying new spending to small sales taxes—and requiring that the taxes expire once the projects were paid for. During his 14-year tenure, his so-called MAPS plans helped Oklahoma City pay for school revitalization, public transit, and downtown improvements. Cornett left office in April on a high note and is seeking the GOP nod for governor.

John Peters inspired an HP audience in Vienna with his talk "Impossible to Possible." Ex-RAF pilot John Peters came to the world's attention in January 1991, when his bruised and battered face flashed onto television screens around the world. It was his disfigured image that became a potent symbol of Saddam Hussein's ruthless aggression. His dramatic and sometimes harrowing experiences reach

deep into our innermost minds, showing us how we can overcome even our worst fears and nightmares. His war was not all as he expected – it became a seven-week ordeal of torture and interrogation testing John Peters to the absolute limit and bringing him close to death.

Anwar Ibrahim

Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia (1993-1998)

Political Reformist



ANWAR IBRAHIM IS A PROMINENT MALAYSIAN politician who served as Deputy Prime Minister and Finance Minister. Since 1998 he has led Malaysia's Justice Party in its mission to strengthen democracy and the rule of law in the country. Although he spent over eight of the last twenty years in detention as a political prisoner, his party achieved a historic electoral victory in the May 2018 Malaysian elections, shattering the ruling party's 61-year hold on power. He was released from jail days after the election and granted a full pardon from politically motivated charges. The new government has indicated that Anwar is the Prime Minister in-waiting and is expected to take over the Premiership of the country within the next two years.

Anwar is highly respected for his principled stance against corruption and his skillful management of the Malaysian economy during the Asian financial crisis. He has called for bold reforms to Malaysia's political economic system in order to remain competitive in the 21st century. He believes an independent judiciary, free media and respect for the rule of law are cornerstones on which Malaysia's economic strength can be expanded. He further believes that public policy should not overlook the plight of the poor and marginalized while at the same time seeking to develop infrastructure, attract foreign investment and grow the economy. The multi-ethnic Justice Party that he leads has provided a template for how Malaysia's diverse ethnic and religious groups can work together towards a common national objective.

Throughout his career Anwar has held key positions in international institutions including President of the UNESCO World Council, Chairman of the Development Committee of World Bank and International Monetary Fund. He has also taught at Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies and St. Antony's College at Oxford.

SKIN IN THE GAME HIDDEN ASYMMETRIES IN DAILY LIFE

by Nassim Nicholas Taleb

A bold new work from the author of *The Black Swan* that challenges many of our long-held beliefs about risk and reward, politics and religion, finance and personal responsibility.

In his most provocative and practical book yet, one of the foremost thinkers of our time redefines what it means to understand the world, succeed in a profession, contribute to a fair and just society, detect nonsense, and influence others. Citing examples ranging from Hammurabi to Seneca, Antaeus the Giant to Donald Trump, Nassim Nicholas Taleb shows how the willingness to accept one's own risks is an essential attribute of heroes, saints, and flourishing people in all walks of life.

As always both accessible and iconoclastic, Taleb challenges long-held beliefs about the values of those who spearhead military interventions, make financial investments, and propagate religious faiths. Among his insights:

- For social justice, focus on symmetry and risk sharing. You cannot make profits and transfer the risks to others, as bankers and large corporations do. You cannot get rich without owning your own risk and paying for your own losses. Forcing skin in the game corrects this asymmetry better than thousands of laws and regulations.
- Ethical rules aren't universal. You're part of a group larger than you, but it's still smaller than humanity in general.
- Minorities, not majorities, run the world. The world is not run by consensus but by stubborn minorities imposing their tastes and ethics on others.
- You can be an intellectual yet still be an idiot. "Educated philistines" have been wrong on everything from Stalinism to Iraq to low-carb diets.
- Beware of complicated solutions (that someone was paid to find). A simple barbell can build muscle better than expensive new machines.
- True religion is commitment, not just faith. How much you believe in something is manifested only by what you're willing to risk for it.

The phrase "skin in the game" is one we have often heard but rarely stopped to truly dissect. It is the backbone of risk management, but it's also an astonishingly rich worldview that, as Taleb shows in this book, applies to all aspects of our lives. As Taleb says, "The symmetry of skin in the game is a simple rule that's necessary for fairness and justice, and the ultimate BS-buster," and "Never trust anyone who doesn't have skin in the game. Without it, fools and crooks will benefit, and their mistakes will never come back to haunt them."

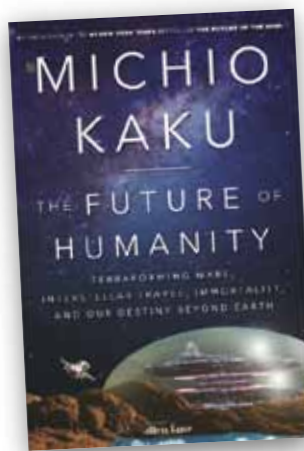

RESCUE REFUGEES AND THE POLITICAL CRISIS OF OUR TIME

by David Miliband

In *Rescue: Refugees and the Political Crisis of our Time* (TED Books 2017), David Miliband takes us from war zones in the Middle East to peaceful suburbs in America to explain the crisis and show what can be done, not just by governments with the power to change policy but by citizens with the urge to change lives. His innovative and practical call to action shows that the crisis need not overwhelm us.

Miliband says this is a fight to uphold the best of human nature in the face of rhetoric and policy that humor the worst. He defends the international order built by Western leaders out of the ashes of World War II, but says now is the time for reform. Describing his family story and drawing revealing lessons from his life in politics, Miliband shows that if we fail refugees, then we betray our own history, values, and interests.
