She founded Ecoware with the sole aim of fixing India's plastic menace. Ecoware disrupted the food packing industry by introducing a fully compostable alternative to plastic and styrofoam. Ecoware is made from the waste of common agricultural crops, that would otherwise be burnt in the open to clear farmland.

One of her greatest successes has been to persuade the Indian Railways, the largest food service operator in India, to switch to biodegradables. Rhea has been featured in many national and international publications – Forbes, Fortune, Hindustan Times, Economic Times, India Today, Gulf News. As a mother to two young children, Rhea know first-hand the harmful impact of pollution on the most vulnerable. This is her constant motivation to do better.
