Chilcote also spent 12 years at CNN where he covered political and business news in Russia, the former Soviet Union, both of Russia's wars in Chechnya, the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, Georgia's "Rose Revolution", Darfur, South Sudan, Kenya, Iran and the intifada in Israel.

Since joining Bloomberg in 2007 in London, Chilcote has held a particular focus on Russia. In the past year, he has interviewed a number of members of the Russian business community, including: Sberbank CEO Herman Gref, Russian Finance Minister Anton Siluanov and Bank of Russia Governor Elvira Nabiullina.
